






European Cleantech Internationalisation Initiative (EC2i)

Background

Between January 2018 and December 2019, five ICN clusters - Green Tech Cluster in Austria, TWEED in Belgium, CLEAN Denmark, Tenerrdis France and Sustainable Business Hub in Sweden conducted a series of SME internationalisation missions to China and the United States through the EU-funded EC2i project.



Implementation

Strategic Partnerships

Strategic partnerships were established with relevant stakeholders in the targeted markets, local market opportunities identified, and opportunities for collaborative business development pursued, which lead to six new business collaborations.

Internationalization

Four matchmaking missions - two in the US and two in China - were organized to accompany 80 European companies into large and dynamic cleantech markets with high growth potential.

Shared Vision

Tools were developed to help SMEs enter those new markets and forme cross-sectoral, multinational consortia along value chains to deliver integrated products and services (Business Intelligence template, SME directory, etc.).
